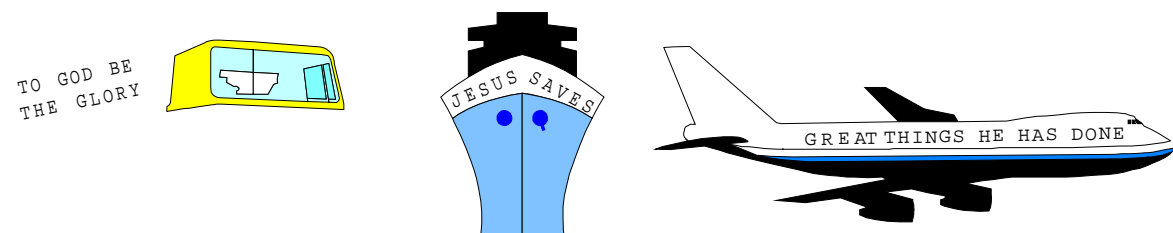
The hunger for understanding God's Word is never-ending. Following are typical "thank you's."

What shall I do with Jesus (Matthew 27:22) in 2007?**

Dear Friends in Christ,

"Officially" the year 2007 has begun and we pray that the Lord will truly make this a **Happy New Year** for you and your loved ones. We praise the Lord for the privilege to **go . . . teach all nations to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you** (Matthew 28:18-20). **Bible Pathway Ministries** is dedicated to world missions. During the year 2006 we have provided thirty tons of Bibles and *Bible Pathways* throughout the world. We are a faith mission and depend upon our Lord to provide the income to allow us to spiritually **"teach all nations"** until Jesus returns. The Lord is opening another year to help answer prayers for Bibles and spiritual help.

As I write this letter I'm sitting here in my office with my mind and heart praising the Lord for the privilege the Holy Spirit has given me and others, to be a blessing to suffering, desperate saints. I will turn 86 years old in 2007 and have been serving the Lord since the day, as a teenager, my mother taught me to give 10% of my weekly allowance in the church offering. She also placed a plaque next to my bed that read "Only one life will soon be passed and only what's done for Christ will last." Then below it read: **Seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness** (Matthew 6:33).

His Kingdom I believed meant His Church and its many responsibilities, and **His Righteousness** I believed meant my personal life needed to be in a right relationship with God. Then my thoughts often were focused on **Present your bodies a living sacrifice . . . be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind** (Romans 12:1-2). Most of my life, I've thought of my miserable failures. But, the Lord interrupted my thoughts and brought the following verse to my mind: **I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Jesus Christ** (Philippians 3:13-14).

As we at **Bible Pathway "press toward the mark,"** we see seven ongoing privileges to **Go . . . teach all nations** along with other like-minded believers. Each one of us must face the question that Pilate asked the crowd: What shall I do with Jesus? Whose kingdom will be built by our efforts? There are just two – the kingdom of God and the kingdom of the world.

We can help build the kingdom of Jesus as He said: Blessed are those servants, whom the Lord when He cometh shall find watching. . . . Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not (Luke 12:37-40).

P.S. Jesus reminds us that as we help the helpless, **ye have done it unto Me** (Matthew 25:40, comp. Mark 9:41).
